Purpose of this packet

This inquiry packet helps Premium Prep Academy understand the student's post-graduate or postsecondary goals, academic standing, development needs, family expectations, and pathway fit before formal enrollment or placement decisions are made.

WHO THIS PATHWAY IS FOR

- Graduating seniors and young adults seeking a structured bridge between high school and their next step.
- Post-grad student-athletes who need academic structure, mentorship, development, exposure, and a credible plan beyond basketball.
- Students who need GED support, college course access, certificate program options, workforce readiness, or career placement preparation.
- Families seeking consistent communication, accountability, structure, and a clear postsecondary plan.

PATHWAY POSITIONING

Premium Prep Academy is not presenting this pathway as a one-size-fits-all program. Each student is reviewed based on academic status, age, eligibility, goals, development needs, and next-step readiness. The objective is to build a clear plan that moves the student toward college, career, certification, military, trades, entrepreneurship, or other postsecondary opportunities.

MULTIPLE PATHWAYS. ONE MISSION.

GED Support

Structured preparation and accountability for students who need to complete a recognized high school equivalency pathway.

College Courses

Postsecondary coursework opportunities for students ready to earn college credit and move closer to a degree.

Certificate Programs

Career-aligned training pathways designed to help students build skills, credentials, and stronger employment options.

Workforce Readiness

Job readiness, professionalism, communication, resume preparation, interview preparation, and career placement support when available.

Life Skills & Mentorship

Character development, leadership, discipline, accountability, financial literacy, and personal development.

Athletic Development

Training, competition, film, exposure, recruitment support, and development for students whose pathway includes athletics.

WHAT PPA PROVIDES

- Pathway review and planning before formal acceptance or placement.
- Academic support, progress monitoring, and accountability communication.
- Mentorship, leadership development, character development, and life skills structure.
- Postsecondary transition support connected to the student's goals and readiness level.
- Athletic development opportunities for students whose plan includes competitive basketball.
- Family/student communication around expectations, progress, concerns, and next steps.



ACADEMIC AND POSTSECONDARY SOURCE

Premium Prep Academy will support each post-grad and postsecondary student through a structured pathway based on the student's academic standing and next-step goals. Depending on the student, this may include GED support, college courses, certificate programs, workforce readiness training, or a combination of approved academic and development supports.

PPA provides the structure around the pathway: accountability, academic check-ins, progress monitoring, mentorship, learning support when available, family/student communication, and development planning. Final course enrollment, certificate requirements, academic placement, transcript needs, testing requirements, and pathway details will be reviewed before enrollment is finalized.

POST-GRAD STUDENT-ATHLETE MODEL

- Designed for students who need additional development after high school before moving into college, junior college, NAIA, NCAA, trade/certificate, military, or workforce opportunities.
- Basketball is treated as one part of the overall pathway - academics, discipline, maturity, life skills, and next-step planning are equally important.
- Roster participation, travel, competition, housing, training, and exposure opportunities are not guaranteed through inquiry alone and will be reviewed separately.

PROGRAM INVESTMENT NOTE

Program investment may vary based on the student's pathway, academic needs, certification or course requirements, athletic participation, housing/travel needs, and scholarship eligibility. Families/students will receive a clear financial outline before any final commitment is made.

Scholarships and payment arrangements

Scholarship opportunities may be available. Payment arrangements may also be discussed before final enrollment, based on pathway fit, timing, eligibility, and available support. No student/family will be asked to make a final commitment without reviewing the financial expectations first.

REVIEW PROCESS

- Step 1** Student/family submits the completed inquiry packet.
- Step 2** PPA reviews academic standing, pathway goals, development needs, eligibility considerations, and program fit.
- Step 3** A consultation is scheduled with the student and parent/guardian or support contact when appropriate.
- Step 4** Academic pathway, postsecondary goals, athletic interest, support needs, and financial expectations are reviewed.
- Step 5** If appropriate, PPA provides formal enrollment next steps, required documents, payment options, and final program expectations.

DOCUMENTS THAT MAY BE REQUESTED

- Government-issued ID or birth certificate.
- High school transcript, diploma, GED record, or current credit record.
- College transcript, placement record, or course history if applicable.
- Athletic film, physical, insurance information, and eligibility documentation if athletics are part of the pathway.
- Financial/payment documents, scholarship request information, or other support documentation if needed.
