Purpose of this packet

This packet is the first step for families interested in Premium Prep Academy's Grades 9-12 pathway for Fall 2026. It helps PPA understand the student's academic standing, family goals, development needs, athletic interest when applicable, and overall pathway fit before any formal enrollment decision is made.

WHO THIS PATHWAY IS FOR

- High school families seeking a more structured, supportive, and accountable academic-development environment.
- Student-athletes who need more than training alone - academics, character, leadership, life structure, and long-term planning.
- Students preparing for college, career, certification, workforce opportunities, or other postsecondary pathways.
- Families who want clear communication, progress monitoring, and a next-level plan built around the student.

PRELIMINARY TUITION PLANNING NOTE

For Fall 2026 planning purposes, the estimated PPA family investment for the Grades 9-12 pathway is \$6,800 for the school year. This planning figure is provided so families can determine interest, ask informed questions, and prepare for the enrollment conversation before making a final commitment.

Payment arrangements may be available. For example, the \$6,800 school-year amount may be discussed as approximately \$680 per month over 10 months or approximately \$850 per month over 8 months, depending on the final payment schedule approved during enrollment. Scholarship opportunities may also be available for eligible families. Final payment terms, due dates, scholarship consideration, and enrollment requirements will be reviewed before any family signs a formal agreement.

ACADEMIC SOURCE AND STRUCTURE

For the Grades 9-12 pathway, academic coursework will be delivered through Liberty University Online Academy. PPA provides the daily structure around the student: supervised academic accountability, academic check-ins, progress monitoring, learning support when available, mentorship, family communication, athletic development when applicable, and college/career pathway planning.

Final Liberty University Online Academy enrollment requirements, grade reporting, transcript process, course expectations, academic calendar, and PPA payment responsibilities will be reviewed with each family before enrollment is finalized.

Enrollment Review Process

- 1 Family submits the completed inquiry packet.
- 2 PPA reviews academic standing, family expectations, development needs, and pathway fit.
- 3 A parent/guardian and student consultation is scheduled.
- 4 Academic pathway, support needs, athletic interest, and college/career goals are reviewed.
- 5 If appropriate, PPA provides formal enrollment next steps and final program details.
